THE BOAT RIDE

You have two options to select how you will travel to Thompson Island:

Private charter from Boston Harbor Cruises

- Thompson Island will make the arrangements, just pick the departure time from Long Wharf and Thompson Island.
- The cost is \$20 per person round trip with a minimum of \$2,000.
- Additional trips are subject to prior approval and additional fees.

Private Thompson Island Ferry

- Groups under 125 may use the Island ferry that departs from the Black Falcon Cruise Terminal in South Boston.
- The cost is \$20 round trip per person with no minimums.
